



Financial Aid and Fees

The Orchestra Now Fellowship provides a full-tuition scholarship and includes a **bi-weekly taxable living stipend**. Please refer to the charts below for a complete breakdown of additional fees and stipend information.

Fees Breakdown

*In the event that a student is granted a **Leave of Absence**, the student will be charged **\$250 per semester**, and **\$500 per year** during said absence.

Master's Degree (Three Years)

TŌN's academic year runs from September to August, with the exception of the third year (For M. M.) and second year (For A.C.), which ends with Bard's Commencement in May.
