



Financial Aid and Fees

The Orchestra Now Fellowship provides a full-tuition scholarship and includes a **bi-weekly taxable fellowship stipend**. Please refer to the charts below for a complete breakdown of additional fees and stipend information.

Fees Breakdown

Tuition	FULL SCHOLARSHIP (FREE)
Enrollment Deposit (One-time payment, nonrefundable)	\$515 (includes \$15 service fee)
Security Deposit (One-time payment, credited upon withdrawal or graduation)	\$500
Health Services Fee (annual) *See next page for important insurance information*	\$470 (\$235/semester)
Registration Fee (annual)	\$200 (\$100/semester)

Please note, the enrollment deposit will be credited to your Student Account and applied to your first semester fees.

*In the event that a student is granted a **Leave of Absence**, the student will be charged **\$250 per semester**, and **\$500 per year** during said absence.

FELLOWSHIP STIPEND BREAKDOWN

Please note: ALL stipends are taxable.

Master's Degree (Three Years)

Year One (September - August)	• Full-tuition scholarship • \$24,000 Fellowship stipend
Year Two (September - August)	• Full-tuition scholarship • \$24,000 Fellowship stipend
Year Three (September - May)	• Full-tuition scholarship • \$21,000 Fellowship stipend

Advanced Certificate (Two Years)

Year One (September - August)	• Full-tuition scholarship • \$24,000 Fellowship stipend
Year Two (September - May)	• Full-tuition scholarship • \$21,000 Fellowship stipend

TÖN's academic year runs from September to August, with the exception of the third year (*For M. M.*) and second year (*For A.C.*), which ends with Bard's Commencement in May. *Additionally, Bard College's policy states that all students must either enroll in Bard's Health Insurance plan, or apply for and be granted a waiver.*
